### **Adult, Juvenile, arrested in July Stoughton Murder**

Following months of continuous investigation, detectives from the Stoughton and Massachusetts State Police tonight arrested an adult from Stoughton and a juvenile from Brockton, for their involvement in the July 21, 2020 murder of Christian Vines, a Randolph youth shot to death in his parked car in Stoughton.

The Brockton 17-year-old was arrested at his home after being indicted today for Murder by a Norfolk County Grand Jury and may be arraigned as soon as tomorrow in Norfolk Superior Court. His name, and possibly details relative to his involvement, will become public at that arraignment.

The adult, Tyleke Curry, 22, of Stoughton had previously been arrested and arraigned for accessory after the fact of the murder and had pled not guilty to that charge in Norfolk Superior Court. Today (Monday, February 22, 2021) he was indicted on the charge of accessory before the fact of the murder.

Jaylen Wallace, who was 17 and a juvenile at the time of the shooting, was arrested and arraigned for murder in August. He has entered a plea of not guilty and is being held without bail.

Further narrative information is likely to be released at the Superior Court arraignment.

"State Police detectives assigned to the Norfolk District Attorney's office and Stoughton Police have poured a great deal of effort and dedication into this investigation," District Attorney Michael W. Morrissey said. "Working with Assistant District Attorney Jennifer Blair as she conducted the grand jury investigation, the Stoughton Police were excellent partners in this. Tonight's arrests do not blunt the senseless loss of Christian Vines, but they are an important step forward."

The DA's Office will release information on the timing of arraignment as it is determined in the morning.
