### One arraigned, one still sought in Randolph homicide

One of the two Worcester men indicted for murder in the [July 2022 shooting](#) outside a Randolph social club was taken into custody and arraigned last week, according to Norfolk District Attorney Michael W. Morrissey. The second man remains at large.

Two men were shot in the parking lot of the Mojito Country Club on Mazzeo Drive at approximately 8 p.m. on July 4, 2022.. One, Ivanildo Cabral, age 29, of Worcester, did not survive his injuries.

"Members of the Massachusetts State Police Violent Fugitive Apprehension Section, Randolph Police Department, Webster Police, and State Police detectives assigned to the Norfolk District Attorney's Office converged on a residence on North Main Street in the town of Webster at roughly 8:30 a.m. Wednesday," District Attorney Michael W. Morrissey said. "Officers found Shawn Johnson, 29, of Worcester at that address and took him into custody without incident."

Johnson was brought to Norfolk Superior Court to answer the indictment warrant on Thursday, March 23. He was represented at arraignment by Attorney Neil Madden and entered a plea of not guilty to Murder, Assault and Battery with a Dangerous Weapon Causing Serious Bodily Injury, Armed Assault with intent Murder, Mayhem, and carrying a firearm.

He was ordered held without bail and will return to court May 31, 2023, for pre-trial Conference, DA Morrissey said. The matter is being handled by Assistant District Attorney Jennifer Blair for the Commonwealth.

Jovani Delossantos, age 29, of Worcester was also indicted in the matter on the following charges: Murder, Assault and Battery with a Dangerous Weapon Causing Serious Bodily Injury, Armed Assault with intent Murder, and Mayhem. He remains at-large. "If any member of the public has information on where Mr. Delossantos is, we ask them not to approach or speak to him, but to call Randolph Police at 781-963-1212," District Attorney Morrissey said.

A third person, Bianca Chionchio, age 28, was also indicted in December charged with Accessory after the Fact of Murder for driving Johnson and Delossantos to New York after the shooting and then returning home without them. She has entered a plea of not guilty and is free on \$5,000 cash bail. She is due in Norfolk Superior Court on June 9 at 2 p.m.
