Milton Police Sergeant pleads not guilty To Westwood assault and civil rights charges

Patricia Lio, 52, of Westwood, entered a plea of not guilty to charges of Assault and Battery on a Household Member and a Civil Rights violation (Assault to Intimidate, Chap. 265 Sec. 39(a)) in Dedham District Court on May 18, 2021, according to Norfolk District Attorney Michael W. Morrissey.

Attorney Kevin Reddington represented Lio at arraignment. The Commonwealth requested three conditions of release: stay away from and have no contact with the minor victim and his family; no abuse of alleged domestic A & B victim; Remain alcohol free with testing during the pendency of the case.

Attorney Reddington assented to the first two but objected to the alcohol-free condition. Judge Michael Pomerole imposed the first two but did not impose the alcohol-free condition.

The matter is due back in Dedham District Court 7/30/21 for pretrial conference.
